Douneside, a holiday country house sits in fifteen acres of beautifully tended gardens and woodlands above Royal Deeside, thirty miles west of Aberdeen. From mid-spring to autumn, Christmas to Easter and at selected times over the winter months, Douneside House and its extensive facilities is open for holidays to serving and retired officers and their accompanying family and friends. It is owned by The MacRobert Trust, a registered charity established by Lady MacRobert to commemorate the lives of her three sons who were killed whilst flying; two on operations with the RAF during World War Two. The MacRobert Trust supports Douneside as a charitable undertaking, thus enabling the provision of high standards of accommodation at subsidised rates.

Facilities

With fourteen rooms and several cottages close-by, Douneside offers full board and can cater for those with special dietary needs. The cellars are well stocked with wines to compliment the delicious home cooked meals, and the bar offers a comfortable opportunity to relax before lunch or dinner.



Children are very welcome at Douneside and cots, bed-rails etc. are provided and there is an outdoor play area for younger children.



The Leisure Centre has a heated swimming pool, Jacuzzi, sauna, fitness room and also, table tennis, pool and snooker tables. *Outdoors* you can enjoy tennis on the all-weather tennis court, whilst on the extensive lawns croquet, putting and badminton are all available.

The Great Outdoors; Douneside is situated on the edge of the Cairngorm National Park which offers walking for all levels of ability and glorious scenery. Fishing is available on the estate lochan (stocked with brown and rainbow trout) and salmon fishing can be arranged on the rivers Dee and Don.
